What is Music Therapy?

Music Therapy:

an established healthcare profession that uses music within a therapeutic relationship to address physical, emotional, cognitive, and social needs of individuals

WHY MUSIC THERAPY?

Over 70 years of research has established connections between:

- Rhythm and motor skills
- Music and memory
- Singing and speech

Research conclusively demonstrates that facilitated music inventions foster individuals' abilities in developing/improving their physical, cognitive, psychosocial and behavioral skills.

Music Therapy

provides sensory stimulation that evokes and regulates motor responses

Facilitates social interaction essential to building relationship

Provides diversion from inactivity, discomfort and daily routine to facilitate treatment adherence

Evokes associations that contribute to an increase in well-being and life quality

Provides opportunities for communication of feelings, needs, and desires

Enhances emotional responses that are integral to learning and change

Provides an enjoyable and nonthreatening means of rehabilitation and recovery

Improve physical and motor functions

> Improve speech/ language skills


Manage anxiety, depression

Pain management

Mood elevation

Facilitate expression of feelings, fears, hope

Increase socialization, acceptance of self



Legislative Action Update Music Therapy State Licensure Advocacy

- SHB 1247, Licensing of Music Therapists passed the Senate floor this Wednesday after 17 years of our persistent effort
- Consumer protection
 - Provide regulatory standards for music therapists
 - Licensed music therapists must be board-certified music therapists (MT-BC)
- Increased access to music therapy


